GROWING UP SAFE

As children grow, how they sit in your vehicle should change. Installing and using a child safety seat in your vehicle can be difficult and frustrating. Research shows more than 80 percent of children in safety seats are incorrectly restrained and eight out of 10 children who need booster seats don't use them. Also, many children 12 years and younger are riding at risk in the front seat in harms way of air bags.

The Mankato Clinic Foundation now offers a class to help parents avoid mistakes that can put their children at risk. You will learn about basic car seat and child passenger safety from certified National Highway Transportation Safety Administration technicians. What's more, you can set up a private safety check-up appointment.
