Before the Exam:

- **Do not eat or drink anything 4 hours before the exam. This includes medicine, gum and hard candy.**
- Do not take any medications containing morphine 24 hours before the exam.
- Tell your provider if you are breastfeeding, pregnant or think you may be pregnant.

During the Exam:

- The technologist will start an intravenous (IV) line in your arm or hand.
- You will receive a radioactive material through the IV.
- You will lie on your back on the imaging table.
- You need to lie still.
- Images will be taken of your abdomen with a special camera for up to 60 minutes.
- Another medicine, Kinevac, will be given through the IV.
- Images will be taken for another 30 minutes while you lie still.
- The exam takes about 90 minutes.

After the Exam:

- The technologist will remove the IV.
- You may return to your normal activities.
- Your provider's office will contact you with the exam results.
